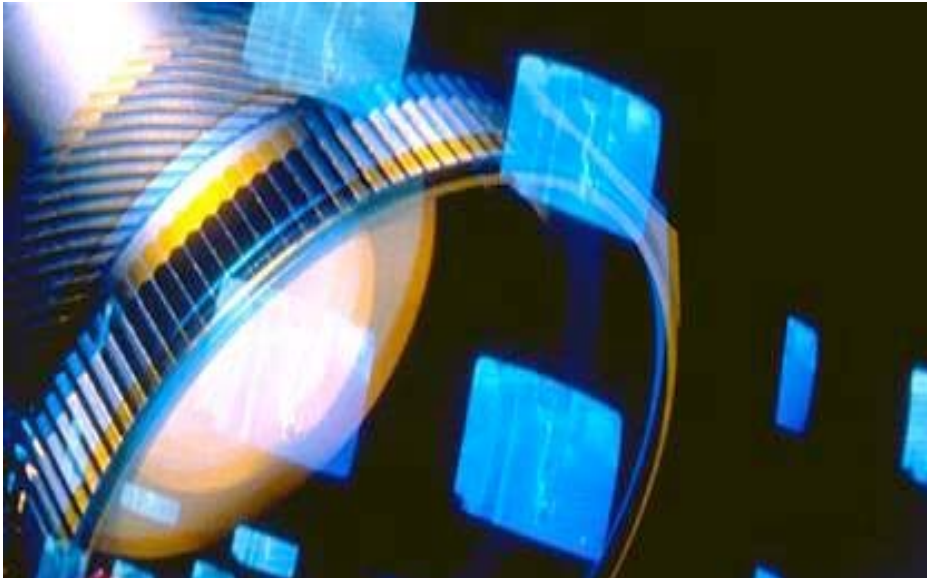

IMPORTANT INFO REGARDING OVERNIGHT REQUESTS

Last quarter the cage moved the checkout time for all overnight requests till 5pm to ensure enough equipment for classes. Because of the large number of people taking out overnight request on Fridays, we were getting really long lines and caused long wait times. To combat this issue, this quarter we are moving the pickup time back to 3pm for any overnight, weekend, or special request. Please note that teachers will be reserving some equipment up to 5pm. You may encounter a situation where your overnight request is approved but some equipment is not available till after 5pm because they are being used for classes. This should not be a problem for the majority of the checkouts but we want to make sure everyone is aware that classes have first priority.

All students are still permitted to checkout weekend equipment from Friday at 3pm, till Monday morning 8:30 am without the need for a special request. That policy has not changed.

New AV Equipment for this Quarter

The following equipment is now available for checkout.

(7) Rode NTG2 shotgun mics. These mics are a high quality shotgun mic that does not require permissions to use.

(6) Sennheiser ME67 Shotgun mics. These mics are very comparable to the performance of the Sennheiser 416 mics. Anyone who has permissions to use the Sennheiser 416 mics automatically has permissions to use these mics.

(14) Sennheiser MKH416 shotgun mics. We added 10 more of these mics over break for a total of 14 available.

(22) Desisti light kits are available. We added 3 more kits over break for a total of 22.

(8) Lowel light kits are available. We added 3 more kits over break for a total of 8.

We also have available an M-AUDIO Microtrack II 2 channel digital recorder to complement the Zoom H4 recorder we have. Permissions for both of these units are granted by Andy Briskar and Cy Anderson.

(17) C stands (complete sets) – Another 5 sets were added over break to give us a total of 17.

(3) M2 MicroX Redrock kits for the Panasonic AG-HVX200 video cameras. These kits have 3 lenses for each kit including Nikon 24mm F2.8, 50mm F1.4, and 85mm 1.8 lenses. These kits will arrive very shortly and workshops will be conducted by Don Gabany for certification and permissions to use them.
